Is it for you?

Are you having difficulty speaking in sentences because of

Broca's Aphasia after stroke OR Nonfluent Primary Progressive Aphasia (PPA)

- Are you at least 18 years of age
- Were you a fluent English speaker before your aphasia

What is the aim of the study?

Design more effective treatment for speaking after stroke / PPA

What does the study involve?

The whole study takes 18 weeks. We will do treatment for 10 weeks:

Weeks 1-2 Assessment: 3 to 5 times for 45 minutes

Weeks 3-7 **Treatment**: 45 minutes. 2 times a week for 5 weeks

Weeks 8-9 Take a break

Weeks 10 - 14 **Treatment**: 45 minutes, 2 times a week for 5 weeks

Weeks 15 – 17 Take a break

Week 18 Assessment: 45 minutes
